The Knox Parks Fund was created by area citizens who wanted to support the parks system and help keep it a lasting part of your community. The fund is managed by the **Community Foundation of Mount Vernon and Knox County**, which was formed in 1944. The Community Foundation is recognized by the U.S. Department of Treasury, Internal Revenue Service for tax exempt purposes, and funds are managed locally. MasterCard and Visa are welcomed.



The Many Ways You Can Help
